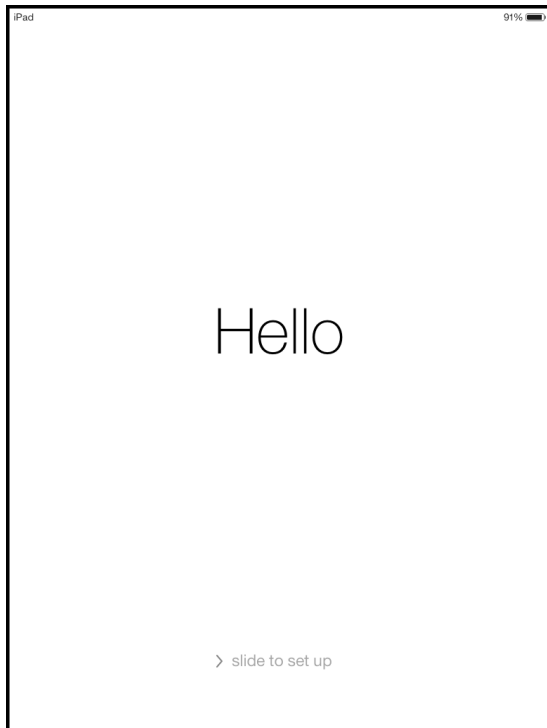
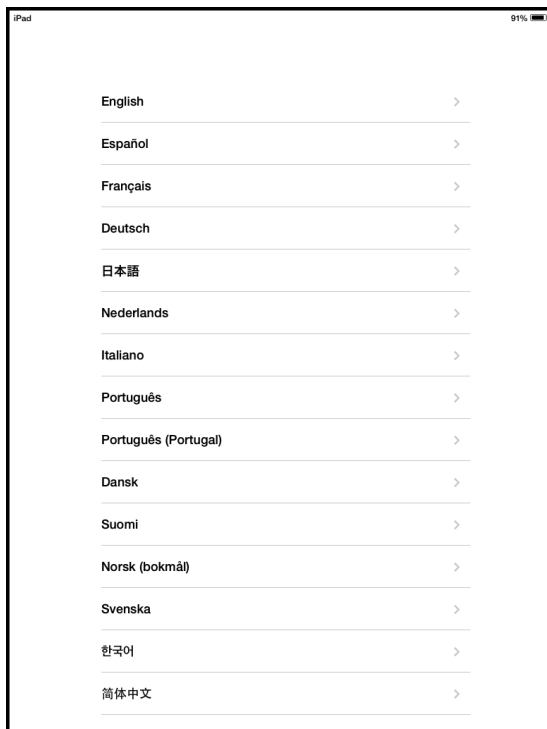


Setting Up Your SU iPad for the First Time

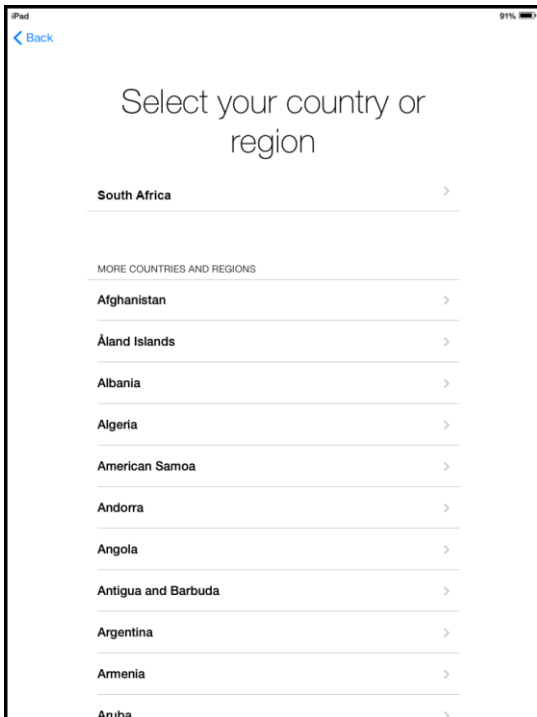
- Switch on iPad and then slide to set up



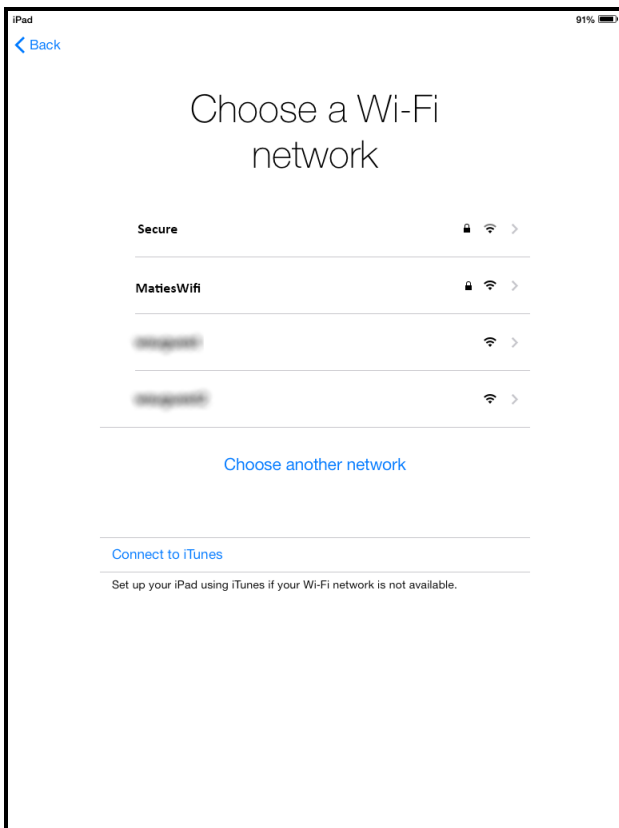
- Select your Language



- Select your Country

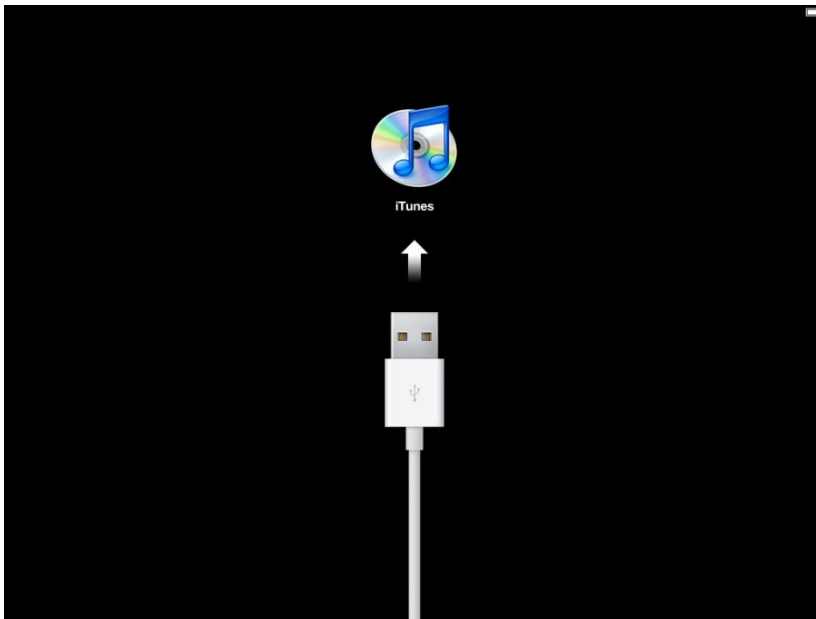


- On the Wi-Fi Networks screen, select Connect to iTunes and confirm to Continue without Wi-Fi



Note: Your iPad needs to connect to the internet, this is not possible on the SU wifi networks without the inetkey being open hence the need to connect to Itunes instead.

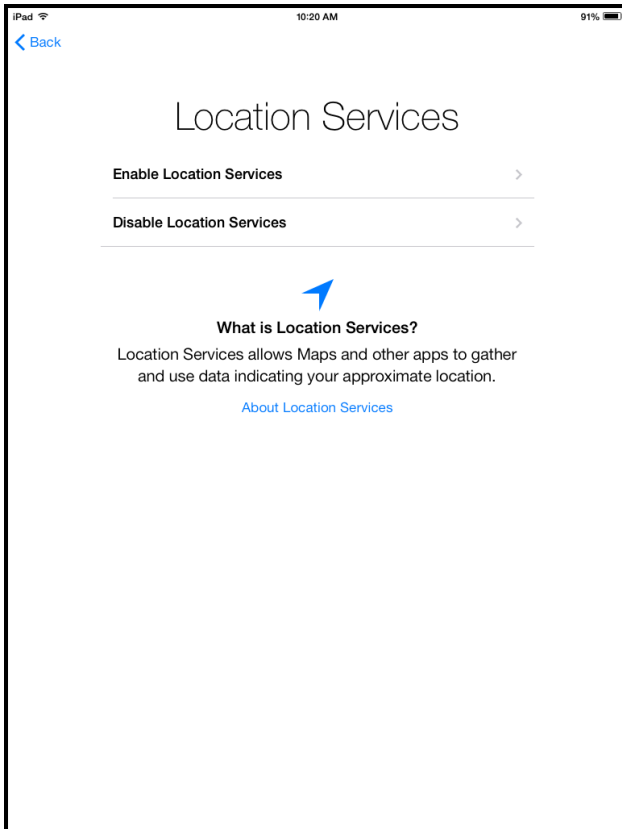
- Connect USB cable to and open iTunes on your computer



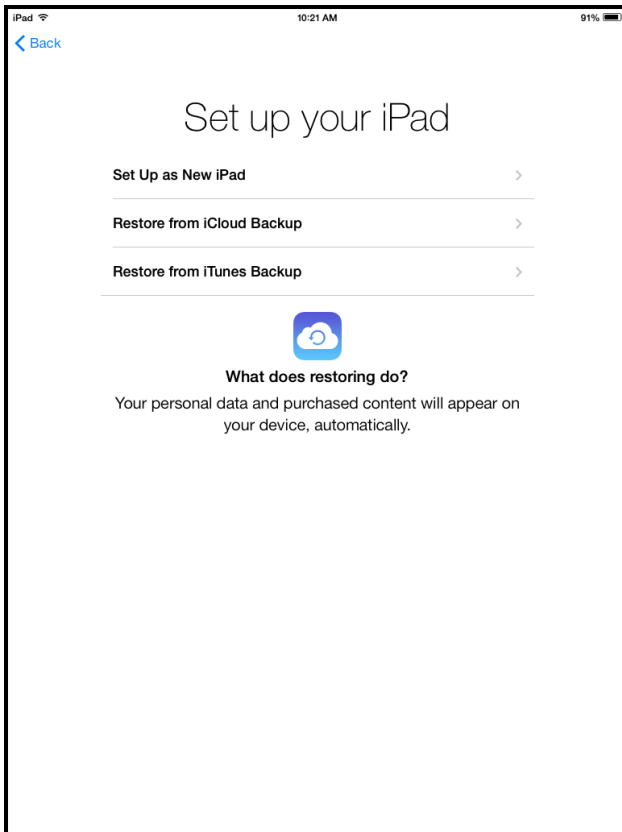
Go to computers and open iTunes

Once that is complete return to the iPad

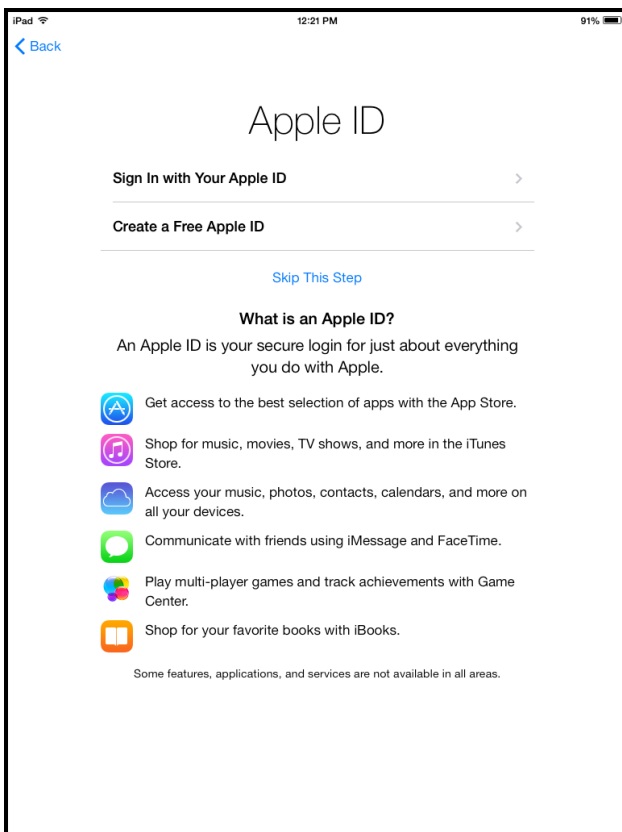
- Enable location services (this is needed for use with weather and map apps)



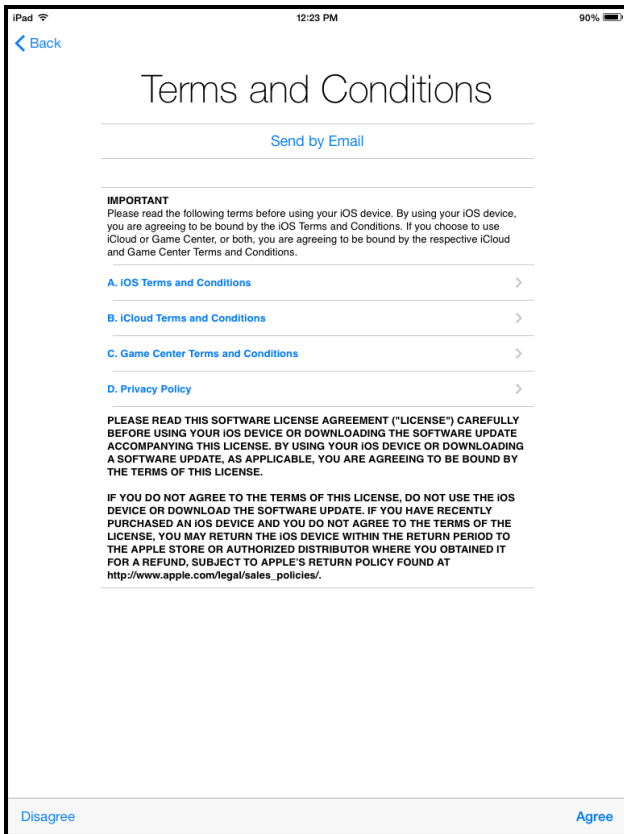
- Select Set up as new iPad



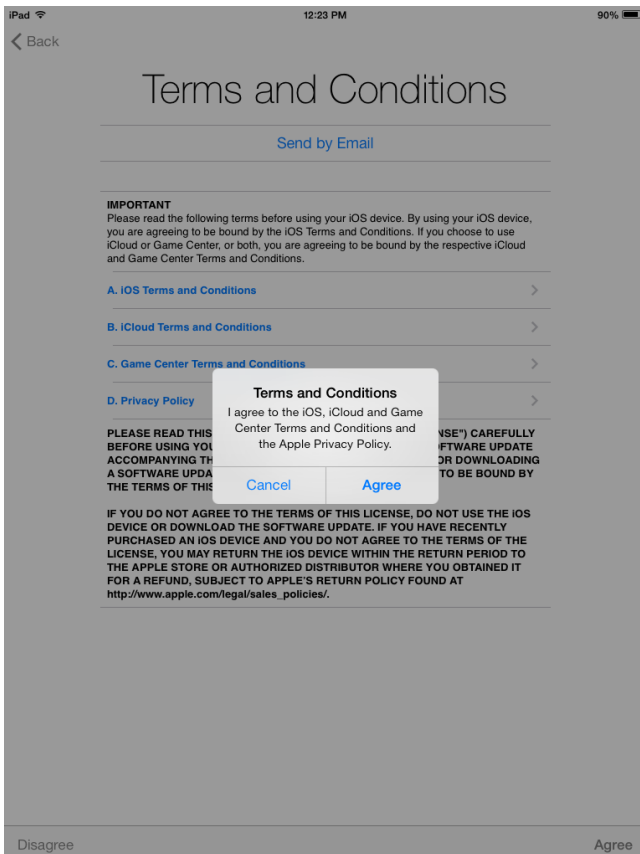
- **Sign in with your Apple ID or Create a Free Apple ID or you can Skip this Step**



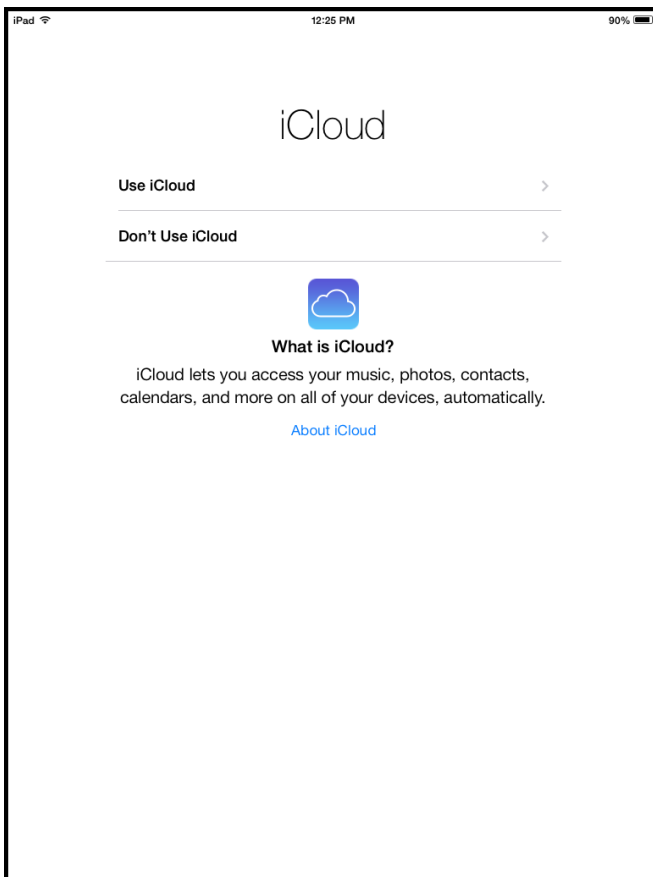
- Read and Agree to the Terms and Conditions and press the Agree button.



- A popup window will appear, press Agree to continue.

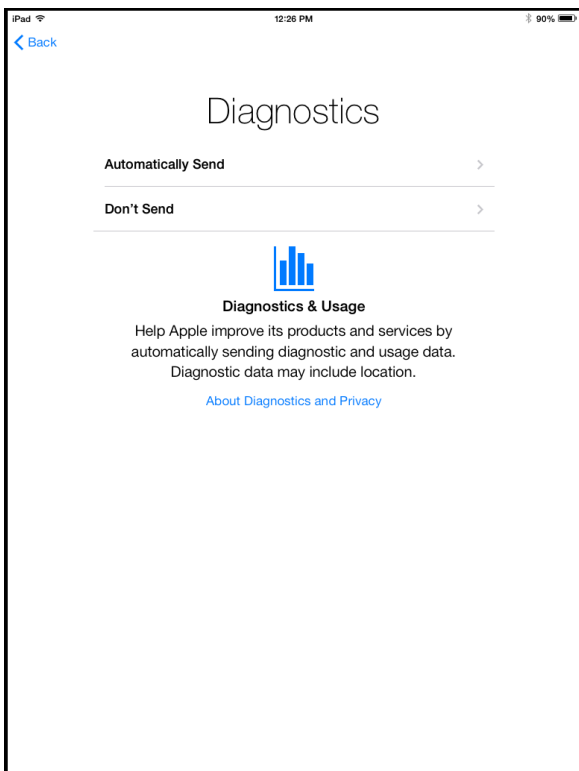


- If you have unlimited data connection you can use iCloud to backup data from the iPad

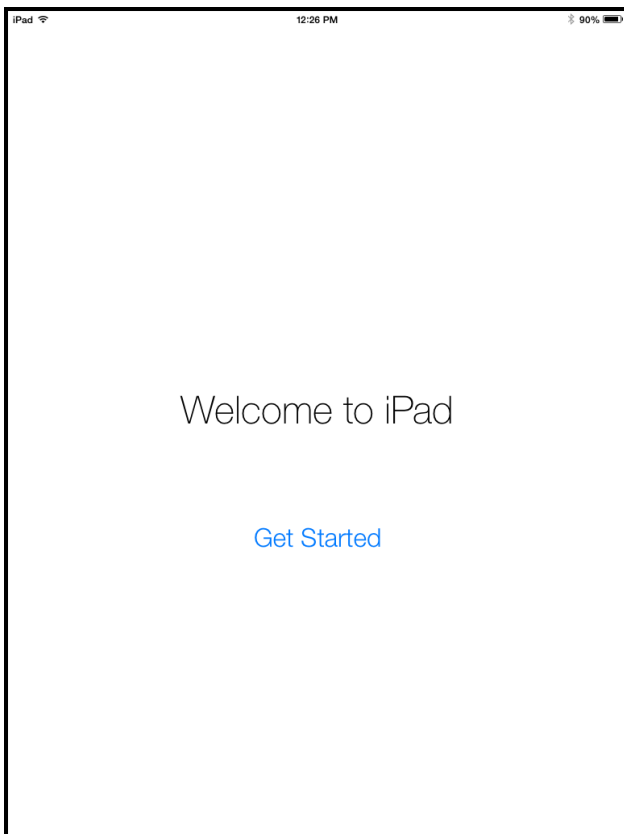


Note: iCloud is Apple's solution to online file storage and communication. Five Gigabytes of space are provided to Apple ID holders to backup their iPad's settings, files, and Apps. iCloud can be used to sync calendars, mail, and other features between multiple devices.

- Choose whether to send information to Apple when an error occurs (user's preference)
